## December at the YSU Foundation

Year-end giving was very strong at the YSU Foundation. As of the printing of this newsletter, year-end gifts were still being received and reconciled. Please note, this report is for all gifts received and processed by December 29, 2017.

New cash gifts received: \$2,275,073  
New pledges received: \$30,620  
Total new philanthropy: \$2,305,693  
Total number of gifts: 580

In addition to the above totals, \$2,512,050 cash on existing pledges was received.

Additionally, one charitable gift annuity for \$50,000 was signed in the month of December.

Of the above December totals, \$3,864,302 in cash will be transferred to the Foundations investment manager Graystone Consulting to be added to the Foundation's endowment.
