Foundation Assets' Market Value Reach All Time High

The YSU Foundation Investment Committee held its semiannual meeting January 29. Graystone Consulting presented a performance report on the Foundation's assets for the period July 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017. Assets held by Graystone Consulting as of December 31, 2017 were \$238,848,257. Assets held internally at the Foundation on December 31, 2017 were \$4,163,829, bringing the Foundation's total assets to \$243,012,086.

Foundation total assets as of December 31, 2016 were \$213,649,019, reflecting growth of \$29,363,067 in calendar year 2017.

The Children's Mental Health Circle of Friends Foundation and Alta Health Care Group, provided a gift of \$10,000 to establish a scholarship, intended to provide opportunities to the Parents of a child enrolled in the Alta Head Start Pre-School Program. The scholarship's purpose is to advance a parents education and prepare them to qualify for professions that will assist them to escape poverty and provide for a stable family environment for themselves and their children.

Qualifying applicants are parents who have a child currently enrolled in the Alta Head Start, with preference given to parents who have a child enrolled in the YSU Alta Head Start classroom. This will allow the parent to attend classes at YSU and during the day possibly visit their child and volunteer in a Head Start classroom.
