The Power of Endowment

The Youngstown Educational Foundation (original name of the YSU Foundation) was chartered with the State of Ohio on October 13, 1966. At this time, fourteen existing scholarships were transferred from the private Youngstown University to the newly chartered, private Youngstown Educational Foundation. Since that time, these scholarships have continued to grow while supporting generations of YSU students annually. Currently providing an estimated five- and one-half times the value of the original gift in scholarship support.
